
Overview

- In accordance with the open data policy adopted by EITI-Guinea Steering Committee and to meet the requirement for systematic data disclosure, EITI-Guinea has opted for the establishment of GOVIN for online submissions

Objectives

The objective of the Steering Committee:

- migration to online declaration
- systematic reporting of data on payments made by mining companies and revenues received by the Government through the State financial authorities; this in harmony with EITI Standards.
- The entities involved are those that submit the declaration forms for the writing of the EITI Reports.

Methodology

To achieve this goal, two training sessions taking into account the barrier measures against Covid 19 took place. On July 8 2020 with the State financial authorities and on July 9 2020 with extractive companies. A joint virtual training course took subsequently place for these two entities.

For a better control of the platform, an additive training (on separate visits) was conducted as part of a pilot project that involved the most contributing entities to the national economy (National Directorate of Taxes, General Directorate of Customs, National Directorate of Treasury and Public Accounting);

This method was built on the basis of old EITI reporting forms;

Govin user manual was provided both online and on physical forms to its users.

The target frequency set by the Steering Committee is once per semester.

Advantages of GovIn

- A periodic declaration programmed for each financial year;
- An online declaration that does not require a physical presence;
- A more recent statement for a better reading of the income to be declare;
- To provide an overview of extractive industries
- Easily usable forms;
- Plans to use Govin for the upcoming EITI Guinea reports.
- Launched by MSG 8 December 2020

Going forward

- Awaiting national consultant adjustments to the forms
- Recruitment of data specialist to coordinate GovIn usage
- Included in Action Plan
